- Manage and develop Risk Awareness and Safety programs
- Participate in accident/incident investigations
- Manage the safety team
- Provide reports and recommendations as required
- Manage and oversee safety programs and policies to work towards achieving the goal of no accidents and to ensure compliance with state and federal laws and environmental standards
