Reporting to the Superintendent, Electrical, the Technologist-Electrical/Process Control is responsible for the on-going operation of all mill computer and process control systems.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Continuously monitors the functioning of the mill's DeltaV DCS system
- Trains mill personnel in the use of the DCS system
- Conducts root cause analysis of system malfunctions, troubleshoots, recalibrates, reprograms and repairs as required on the DeltaV system
- Constantly reviews and tunes control loops to optimize performance
- Provides all Delta V configurations while interacting with metallurgy to formulate process control strategies.
- Performs scheduled maintenance of equipment and controls
- Maintains an inventory of spare parts, required documentation and submits reports
- Maintains effective information exchange with materials, operations and maintenance departments to resolve common issues or problems
