### **SENIOR FOREMAN - MINE PRODUCTION**

The Gibraltar Open Pit operation consists of 4 crews, each having over 30 operators working a 4x4 schedule. Daily mining rate for 2011 is projected to be +200,000 tons per day. This is to be accomplished by utilizing a fleet of equipment that consists of: one P&H 2800 electric shovel, one P&H 4100 electric shovel, one B1495 electric shovel, 3 electric blast hole drills, 20 haul trucks of various models and sizes and numerous support equipment. The loading and haulage equipment is tracked and measured by use of the WENCO Dispatch System.

**Reporting to the General Foreman, Mine Operations the Senior Foreman-Mine Production will be responsible for:**

- Exercising overall control of shift activities, delegating responsibility for load/haul to the Production Foreman
- Routinely taking charge of support equipment activities, primary crushing, projects and blasting but may designate other qualified personnel to do so for training or employee development purposes
- Ensuring production targets are achieved
- Applying operating standards and employing personnel and equipment to maximize effectiveness
- Completing shift production reports
- Maintaining effective information exchange with Production Foreman and supervisors in related departments

#### **Qualifications**

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Must possess an open pit shift boss certificate and have a minimum of 8 years varied operations experience within an open pit mining environment
- Mine Engineers with 3-4 years experience would be considered a plus
- Demonstrated ability to organize, direct and supervise

- Use of a dispatching system would be a benefit
