Reporting to the Superintendent, Maintenance Engineering, the Senior Planner- Maintenance is responsible for establishing, communicating and monitoring short and long range plans and schedules for the maintenance of all mine site mobile equipment and ore processing equipment and facilities. This is accomplished by working closely with the materials department, maintenance foremen and operations customers.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Analyzes historical trends and prepares forecasts of future maintenance activities
- Develops and communicates to all affected departments, daily, weekly monthly and annual maintenance plans
- Monitors implementation of the plan, and coordinates changes as required
- Contributes to meeting equipment availability targets within budget
- Works closely with materials department to ensure availability of required parts and materials
- Generates maintenance department performance reports and coordinates the weekly maintenance planning meeting
- Assists in the preparation of the annual maintenance department budget and demonstrates an awareness of costs by performing activities in a cost effective manner
