



GIBRALTAR MINE

Taseko Mines Limited of Vancouver, B.C. is a mining exploration, development and production company focused on creating wealth through the growth and development of current assets, as well as the acquisition of other promising projects. Taseko's main assets are the Gibraltar copper-molybdenum mine, the Prosperity gold-copper project, the Harmony Gold and Aley Niobium prospects. The Gibraltar Mine, located near the City of Williams Lake in the beautiful Cariboo region of British Columbia, is the second largest open pit copper mine in Canada with daily mill throughput of 46,000 tons. Gibraltar is currently undergoing upgrades to the mill and concentrator which will increase mill throughput to 55,000 tons per day and results in a 27 year mine life based on current reserves. The company's Prosperity Project located 125 km south west of Williams Lake, hosts a large gold-copper reserve, has recently been granted a Provincial Assessment Certificate and is being advanced through permitting.

ELECTRICAL MAINTENANCE PLANNER

Reporting to the Electrical General Foreman, the Electrical Maintenance Planner will be responsible for:

- Organizing, planning, scheduling and inter-departmental coordination of all major electrical and instrumentation related maintenance activities for the Mine (Open Pit) and the Ore Processing Plant (Mill) including ordering parts and materials to ensure availability when needed.
- May be required to provide relief supervision coverage.
- Developing short and long-range maintenance management plans, budgets, and forecasts.
- Ensuring that all related maintenance plans are communicated, scheduled and planned in a safe and efficient manner, encompassing daily, weekly, and long term plans.
- Acting as the primary department contact with the site Purchasers, OEM's, Vendors, and Contractors, generates and maintains maintenance performance reports and communicates the effect that planned maintenance has on key performance indicators.
- Working closely with maintenance personnel to continually improve operational reliability and with the preventative maintenance teams by providing supporting information such as; oil analysis, NDT, revised service procedures and vibration analysis results.
- Ensuring the accuracy of the 4site data base, equipment history, and the 'Application Parts List'.

Preference will be given to candidates with the following qualifications. However those with a similar combination or experience, education, and training, will also be considered.

- Electrical or Instrumentation T.Q. and several years of experience in the mining industry.
- Preference will be given to candidates with advanced levels of related technical school or university education combined with several years of experience in the mining industry.

- Strong; leadership, above average verbal and written communication and interpersonal skills and proven successes working within a team environment.
- Strong; organizational, planning, computer and analytical skills and experience managing preventative maintenance programs (with supporting work experience).
